January - April 2020

Between Jan-Apr 2020 it is likely that the group will meet along with relevant officers from Kingston in order to ensure that recommendations are embedded. The group will be convened by Kingston Council's Transformation Team, including Genine Whitehorne, Sophia Severin and Nicola Marven, but each meeting will be chaired by a different member of the group as a whole. An agenda will be drawn up prior to each meeting and shared at least 3 days before it will take place. Actions, issues and recommendations will be recorded at subsequent meetings and circulated to the group.
