COVID-19 and Flu Vaccination Programme 2023/24

- Autumn flu and COVID-19 vaccination programmes **commenced** in England on **11/09/2023** earlier than planned
- Precautionary measure following the identification of a new Covid variant BA.2.86
- Adult care home residents, the housebound and those at highest risk are being offered vaccination first and all residents to be vaccinated before **22/10/2023**
- Anyone eligible for the COVID-19 autumn booster can book via the [NHS website](#), by downloading the NHS App, or by calling 119 for free if they can't get online
- COVID-19 and flu pop up clinics organised for Kingston Library, kingston Hospital (Out Patients) & St Joseph's Catholic Church New Malden. Kingston University pop up for eligible staff. Other in locations to be confirmed.

- We are urging eligible people to come forward for their jab as soon as they are invited by NHS England
