







Just under 1,000 residents had their first dose in the week to July 25th
 Three quarters (range 72-82%) of Kingston's adult population have had at least one vaccination

Another busy week for second doses, with 6,000 taking place. Over 60% (range 57-65%) of adult residents are now fully protected.


Proportion of Kingston residents vaccinated to July 25th 2021, by age group

- To keep our rates going down, we need to find as many **COVID-19 cases in Kingston as possible** - and 'break the chains of transmission' to other people

Key vaccination messages

- **18+** can now book their vaccinations online through the NHS National Booking System



If you're aged over 18, a carer or have an underlying health condition, call 119 or visit nhs.uk/covid-vaccination to book your COVID-19 vaccination appointment.

- **Are you due?** Book your second jab now - **8 week interval**, not 12
- Local walk-in vaccine clinics are being updated all the time

Book your -19 Pfizer Vaccination Appointments available



THOUGH WE HAVE MOVED TO STEP 4 OF THE ROADMAP...

ALWAYS REMEMBER THE BASICS - HANDS - FACE - SPACE & FRESH AIR

- **Keep rooms well ventilated.**

The virus is spread through aerosol particles in the air, so opening windows regularly can cut the amount of virus present in the air in any room.

- **Wear a face covering.**

In shops, hairdressers, barbers, on public transport and in other indoor spaces where social distancing is hard.
